Repertoire. We've introduced all songs for the spring show, but they're not all learned yet.

Workshop on presentation skills. On Saturday, March 5, Steve Katz coached us and suggested moves for our contest set. Individual singing improvement. Paul Eastman is discussing with each individual who filled out a singing improvement form how to work toward the goals written down. Individual or group instruction will follow after Paul finishes the discussions.

Attracting New Singers. Cubberley Community Day and the Vocal Clinic are coming up. Both are opportunities for us to show others how much fun we have singing and to invite others to join us.
