Rehearsal assistance for Sean. VJ is leading us in dancing during our warmup/craft session. Jim Sherman concentrates on integrating moves into our singing. This gives our Director the freedom to focus his attention on singing.

Budget. We don't expect to purchase much sheet music or learning recordings in the next few months, but will defer this until the 2017 budget year. Due to Board action in September, our treasury is expected to become healthier in the short term, so we can afford expected music expenses. Planning for long-term funds is yet to be done.
