- 1. Cabaret 2017 turned out to be a successful event. There was significant concern about ticket sales up to the day itself but we did make a reasonable profit. One of the things we should initiate is an inventory list of items (bowls; serving utensils; etc.). Their location and quantity should be determined and noted after each year. Those quantities and storage location could change so we should document them and put the document on Groupanizer.
- 2. It has been suggested that we establish a performance standard for chapter quartets. The objective is to enhance the audience experience at our shows. The Music Team will discuss this at their next meeting and put a plan in place. (Unless informed otherwise, I believe this to be a Music Team decision and not a Board decision.)

 - Dec 16 Palo Alto Farmer's Market
