Old Business

Report on Dan Heckerman action - A letter was sent to the national organization requesting that if Dan renews his society membership, he will not be renewed in our chapter.

<u>Cabaret 2013 Update</u> – First Strike, a quarter of college-age guys from VIH, is signed up to be the headliner. The board suggested that a placemat be used instead of a program, and that the placemat could contain advertising in addition to a cast list.

<u>Guest Director</u> – This was covered in the Music VP report.

<u>Change of Rehearsal Day</u> – After a lengthy discussion the consensus was that there is not a reason to change rehearsal day at this time.

Spring Show update – The quartet Artistic License has been signed up to be the headliner.

<u>Holiday Chorus Performance Options</u> – We will limit our singouts to four performances for the entire chorus. If we get requests for senior living locations, we will fill them with quartets and VLQs.

<u>Officer Elections for 2014</u> – The nominating committee is at work and has only 1 or 2 nominations yet to fill.

New Business

<u>Plan for Website Update</u> – Nigel is making progress in this. Dave K did some background research into other chorus/performing arts websites. It was suggested that those with strong opinions work with Nigel directly.
